- 1. State Council Delegate
- 2. Region 1 Director
- 3. Region 3 Director
- 4. REAC Director (2 positions available)

1. State Council Representative

CTA's top policy-making body is the State Council of Education. Meeting four times a year, the council's nearly 800 delegates elect the three state-level CTA officers and the CTA Board of Directors. Council also sets forth CTA policy, develops legislation, and makes recommendations in general elections. CTA-AE State Council Representatives attend all CTA State Council meetings as representatives of Aspiring Educators.

2. Regional 1 Director and Region 3 Director

Regional directors work with the Vice President of CTA-AE to coordinate state membership recruitment. They also work with and support local chapters and members in their region to provide resources, leadership, and guidance. Find out what region you are in here.

3. Racial Equity Affairs Committee Director (REAC)

We are looking for two more individuals to join our REAC team. These individuals work on racial, ethnic, and social justice issues in education.

A MESSAGE FROM CTA-AE REAC DIRECTOR JIMMY SALVADOR-CONTRERAS:








NEA ASPIRING EDUCATORS UPDATES

Get ready to vote in the 2024 General Election!

NEA and CTA is here to help you make sure you are already to vote this November! Make sure to complete these 5 steps to ensure you have everything you need to vote!



Check your voter registration status: If it's been a while since you've voted (or even if it hasn't), now's the time to make sure you're registered at your current address.

2 Register to vote: Not registered to vote? Take the time to sign up now—it only takes 2 minutes.
